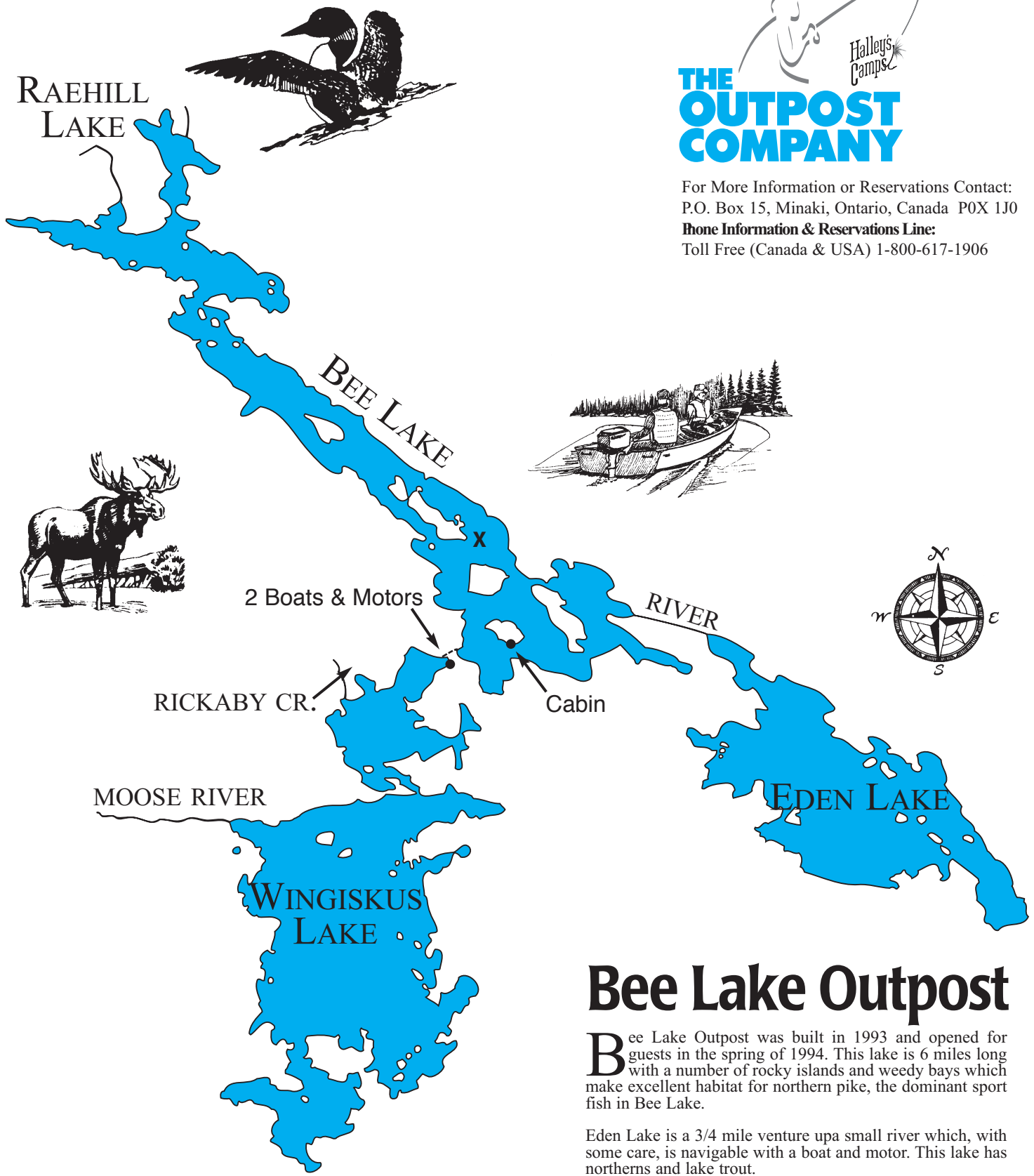

Bee Lake Outpost

Bee Lake Outpost was built in 1993 and opened for guests in the spring of 1994. This lake is 6 miles long with a number of rocky islands and weedy bays which make excellent habitat for northern pike, the dominant sport fish in Bee Lake.

Eden Lake is a 3/4 mile venture up a small river which, with some care, is navigable with a boat and motor. This lake has northern and lake trout.

Wingiskus Lake is a 150 yard portage to the south. The portage is well cut and marked. There are two boats and motors on this large body of water where the smallmouth bass are sure to test your fishing skills.

Rae Hill Lake is a small lake at the northwest end of Bee Lake. To access this lake, you can pull your boat and motor through small narrows.
