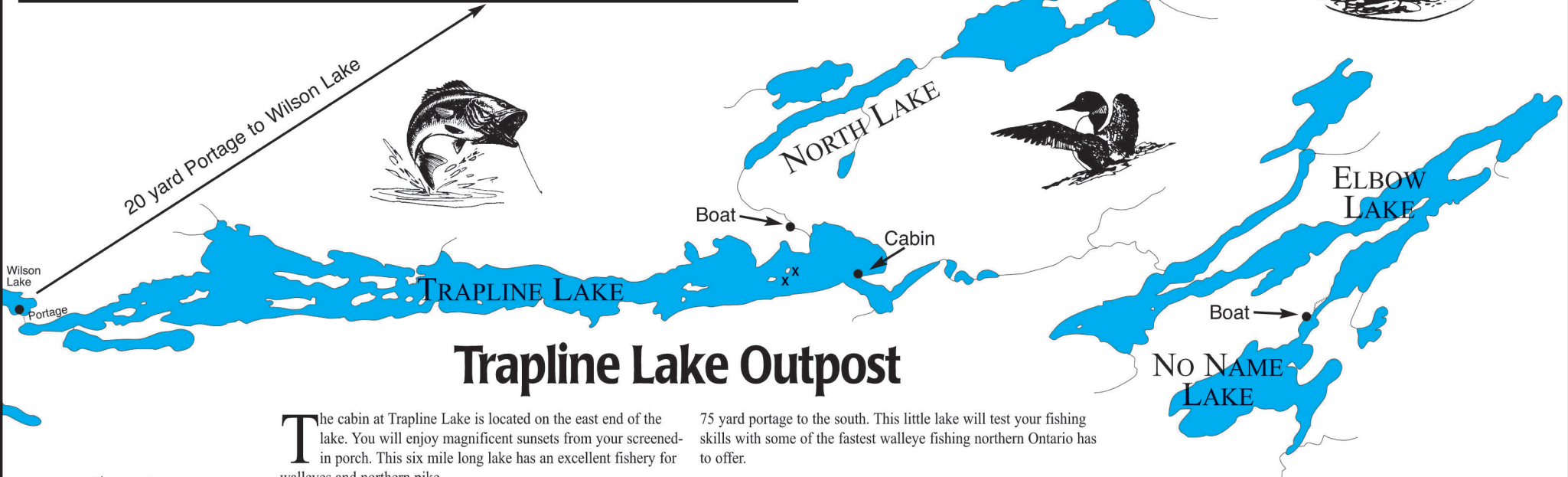
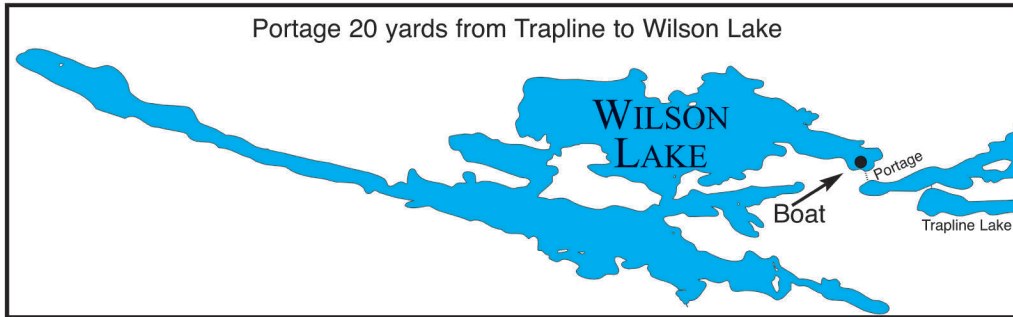

Trapline Lake Outpost

The cabin at Trapline Lake is located on the east end of the lake. You will enjoy magnificent sunsets from your screened-in porch. This six mile long lake has an excellent fishery for walleyes and northern pike.

Elbow Lake is located to the east of Trapline Lake. To access this lake you travel down the Elbow River for two miles. This trip will take you through an area where the sighting of moose or bear is quite common. This is an excellent walleye and northern pike lake.

After travelling to Elbow Lake you can access No Name Lake via a

75 yard portage to the south. This little lake will test your fishing skills with some of the fastest walleye fishing northern Ontario has to offer.

North Lake is 3/4 of a mile to the north down a 50 yard portage. This again is an excellent walleye and northern pike lake.

Wilson Lake is located at the west end of Trapline Lake and is only a 20 yard portage away. There will be a boat waiting for you on this lake. Wilson Lake supports an excellent fishery for large walleye, as well as lake trout and northern pike.
